

# Wedding Day Beauty Checklist



- ✓ Punctuality is extremely important. Please make sure the wedding party has a copy of the schedule of the day's events as well as the styling schedule.
- ✓ Please have the wedding party arrive to be styled with clean, dry hair. It is a common belief that hair holds better if it is dirty, however, I prefer to work with clean hair. The hair's ability to hold the style is a matter of product and technique, not cleanliness. If an attendant is having their makeup done, it is preferable that they arrive with clean, moisturized skin.
- ✓ Esthetics services such as facials and waxing should be done at least a week before the wedding to prevent adverse reactions. Manicures and pedicures should be done 1-2 days before the wedding. Over-scheduling a wedding day creates unnecessary time crunches and stress.
- ✓ Any pre-wedding plans for hair color or style changes should be discussed with the stylist.
- ✓ The styling schedule is created based on how many members of the wedding party pre-requests hairstyling and/or makeup application. Some extra time is allotted in the schedule, however, add-ons are not guaranteed. It is helpful to provide a firm number of people requiring services. The schedule will be created with priority to the bride.
